As an applicant, I have read and understand the following:

- 1. This application may be ranked against others applying for technical and cost share assistance depending on demand and available funds. If the project(s) is approved, conservation practice(s) installed will be bound by a maintenance and landowner agreement. Terms of the agreement vary by practice.
- 2. By applying for technical assistance you will be granting the English River Watershed and/or its designated representatives the right of ingress and egress to your land for the purpose of conducting surveys, planning, and/or inspecting conservation works of improvement during the period the associated best management practice agreements are in force.
- 3. The Iowa Watershed Approach is a voluntary program and the applicant may receive technical and cost share assistance from U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Iowa Watershed Approach project. Eminent domain authority does exist but <u>WILL NOT</u> be used to move forward with this project. Any potential project location(s) on the applicant's property is not required for the overall success of the watershed project. The applicant may withdraw from participating at any time prior to construction.
- 4. Copies of project designs and plans will be provided to the Iowa Flood Center as part of their Iowa Watershed Approach project study, to be used in computer models to study the impact of conservation best management practices on flood reduction.
