Guest Speaker: Chris Kahle, IDNR Floodplain Mapping Project

Chris presented on the IDNR Flooplain Mapping program and the latest efforts to help communities across Iowa identify mitigation opportunities.

National Disaster Resiliency – Iowa Watershed Approach Updates

Bailey provided updates on the Iowa Watershed Project. To date, 62 applications for technical assistance have been received, 547 individual structures have been designed, and current construction estimates sit at approximately \$3.8 million. There have been two bundles of projects sent out to bid and construction has begun on both bundle. There are two more bundles of projects anticipated to be let out to bid in 2020, one in March or April of 2020, and the second before the end of Summer 2020.

Iowa County Secondary Roads Project – (Craig Just)

Bailey introduced an emerging project with Iowa County Secondary Roads. The project is funded by Iowa Watershed Approach planning funds and will identify infrastructure in the IWA project areas of the ERW repeatedly impacted by flooding, and engineer improvement projects to address the issues. The project is a partnership between the Iowa County Engineer, Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division, Iowa Flood Center, East Central Iowa Council of Governments, and the ERWMA.

2019 Stream Monitoring Handouts

Bailey provided handouts summarizing water quality monitoring data for the 2019 sampling year.
